***WANTED FOR ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO COMMIT RAPE***  
***And Residential Burglary***



**Synopsis:**

On 03/05/10 at about 1300 hours, a female was on the enclosed front porch at her home in the 1000 block of Olive Ave in the city of Vista. An unknown male approached the victim, told her that she was pretty, and demanded entry. The female demanded the male leave and attempted to get into her house away from him. The male opened the screen and entered the patio, grabbed the victim's arm, and told her that he was going to "gut her". The victim punched the suspect several times while screaming for help, and with the assistance from her dogs was successful in getting the suspect to flee.

The public's assistance is sought in helping identifying the suspect from the image above, or providing information regarding any similar type crimes in the area. (SEE P.2 FOR DETAILED DESCRIPTION)
