INVESTIGATION INFORMATION WANTED UPDATED INFORMATION

SYNOPSIS:

On 12/23/09 at about 0122 hours, an unknown male driving a large truck pulled into the Taco Bell Parking lot located at 910 E. Vista Way, Vista and stole two surveillance cameras from the rear of the Taco Bell Building. The incident was captured on store surveillance. The video showed the unknown male drive into the parking lot. The unknown male gets out of his vehicle and walks around the rear of the business looking at the surveillance cameras. The unknown male gets back into his vehicle and drives to the back of the business and removes the cameras off the wall. The vehicle is a large white truck with an unknown type load on the rear of the truck.
