Robbery Suspects Sought

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

December 22, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego County Sheriff's Department detectives to help identify and apprehend the suspects responsible for robbing a liquor store in Imperial Beach.

Detectives said on December 17, 2009, at about 9:00 a.m., two male suspects entered the Mercado Shores Liquor Store, located at 639 7th Street in Imperial Beach, to rob the business. Suspect #1 pointed a black semi-automatic gun at the clerk and demanded money. Suspect #2 forced the clerk to the ground and bound his hands and feet. Suspect #2 used a stun gun (dry stunned) on the victim at least ten times. The suspects left with an undisclosed amount of cash.

The clerk sustained minor burn injuries and burn marks as a result of the stun gun strikes. He was treated at the scene and released.

Suspect descriptions:

- #1 Suspect: Hispanic male adult, about 5' 10" tall. He was heavy set with a tattoo on the lower outer corner of his right eye of a circle and a tattoo on beneath his left eye of either a number 13 or 14. He wore a silver hooded jacket and blue jeans.
- #2 Suspect: Hispanic male adult, about 5' 10" tall, skinny with a shaved head and a tattoo just beneath the outer corner of the left eye of the number 13. He wore a black jacket and jeans.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity and location of these suspects to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the persons responsible for this crime.
