Up to a \$1,000 Reward

Detectives Seek Public's Help to Identify Suspect Responsible for Indecent Exposure

Release Date: July 8, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego County Sheriff's Department Vista detectives, is seeking the public's assistance to identify and locate the suspect responsible for exposing himself to three young girls. Detectives are also asking anyone who has been a victim of a similar crime to please call Detective Lisa Jenkins at the Vista Sheriff's Station.

On July 01, 2009 three girls, ages 12-14, were walking in the area of Phillips Street and Valley View Place in Vista when a man in a grey truck stopped in the middle of the road next to them. The driver (suspect) opened the truck's door, put one foot out and looked directly at the girls while he masturbated. The girls ran to a nearby residence to get help and report the incident.

The suspect is described as a White male adult between 30-45 years old. His had no facial hair but had wrinkle lines on his forehead. He also is described as having "fluffy" hair with some grey in it.

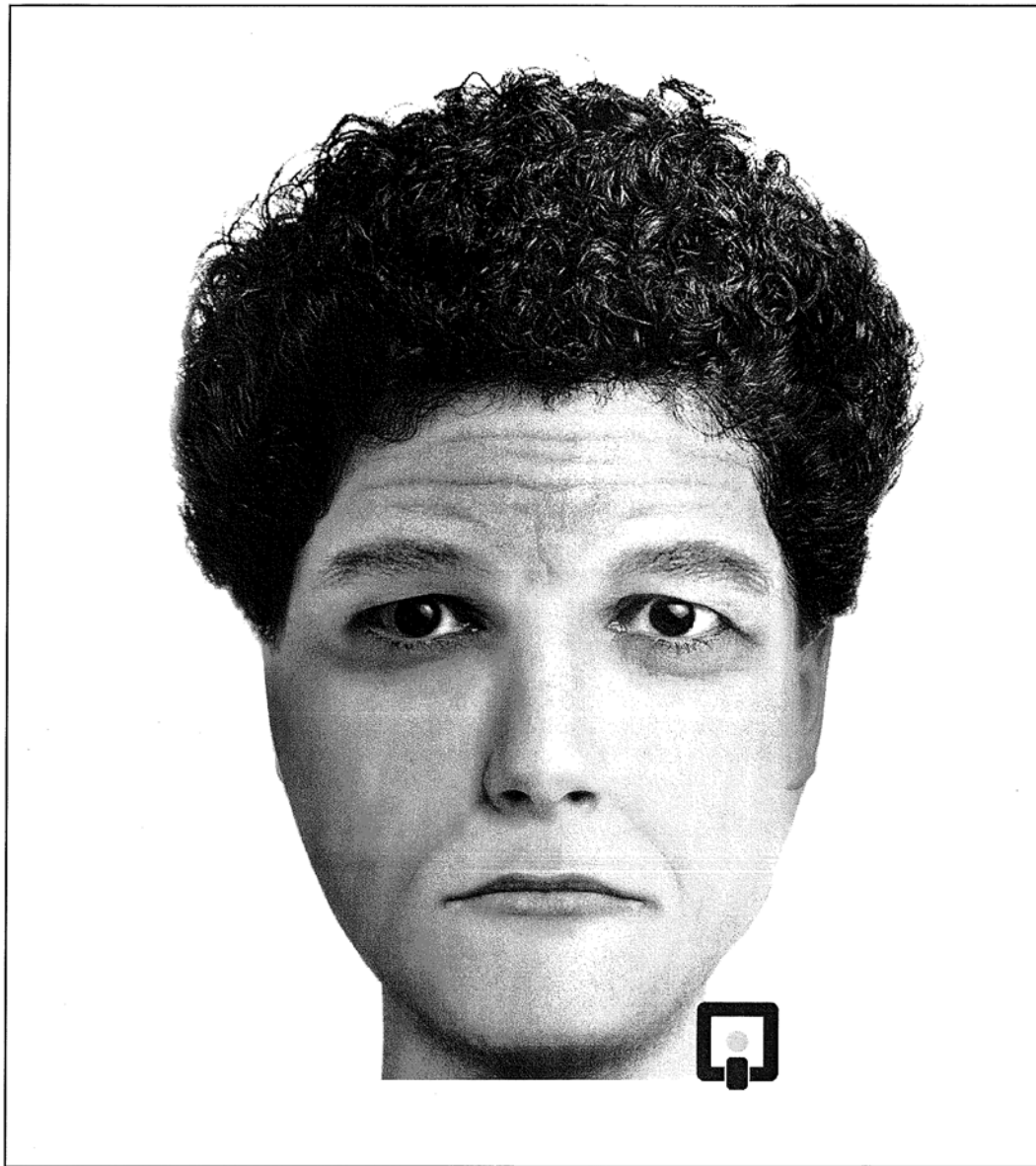
The suspect's vehicle is described as a Toyota or Nissan 2-door pickup truck without an extra cab. It is either grey or faded black in color. The truck also had very large V shaped stripes, stacked on top of each other, on the entire length of the driver's side door.
