Missing Person Under Suspicious Circumstances Have You Seen Cynthia Dyann Coleman?



San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the San Diego County Sheriff's Department's Homicide Unit continue to look for leads in the disappearance of Cynthia Dyann Coleman.

On September 3, 1986, 23-year-old Cynthia Dyann Coleman left her home on the Barona Indian Reservation to go to a nearby supermarket to give away a litter of kittens. Cynthia's mother reported her daughter missing on September 8, 1986 after she failed to return home and made no contact with her family.

At the time of her disappearance, Cynthia stood 5'1" tall and weighed about 110 pounds. She had long brown hair and brown eyes. Cynthia had "Fats" tattooed on her right hand and "Lady" tattooed on her left hand. (SDSD CN: 86-55354H)
