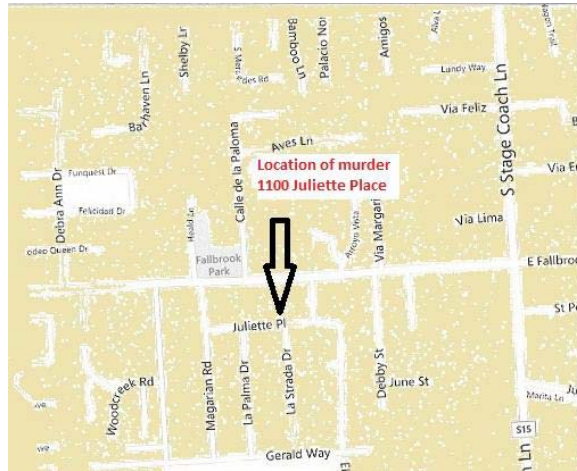


\$1,000 Reward

Who Murdered Bertha Popoca?



San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the San Diego County Sheriff's Department's Homicide Detail continue to look for leads to help identify and locate the person responsible for the 1990 murder of 52-year-old Bertha Popoca.

On the afternoon of February 27, 1990, Bertha Popoca's son went to her house, located at 1100 Juliette Place in Fallbrook, to check on her welfare since family and friends had not been able to contact Bertha in the last few days. When the son entered the home he found his mother, Bertha Popoca, dead in the living room.

Sheriff's deputies determined that Bertha Popoca's death was a homicide. Her case remains unsolved but Cold Case detectives continue to investigate this crime.
