



UNINSURED?

If so Medi-Cal, Covered California, and the Affordable Care Act may have what you need!

Health Care Reform changes now mean you can get health care coverage regardless of income.

Medi-Cal is offering free health care to those who qualify. Most Medi-Cal services are free, which eliminates monthly fees and co-pays. Medi-Cal income limit: \$16,105 for an individual or \$32,913 for a family of four.

- Preventative Care and treatment is now being covered
- Must be a Legal California Resident
- Free Coverage & Care

For your convenience there are 58 community clinics throughout San Diego County who can provide the services you need. Many private doctors also accept Medi-Cal.

If your income is above the Medi-Cal limits you may still qualify for reduced cost insurance.

After your release you will have 60 days to enroll.
